SEE FIRST is a 2-year Erasmus+ project that aims to provide methods and tools to foster the employability young individuals through upskilling their soft skills (i.e. communication, creative thinking, work ethic, teamwork, and more).

It targets recent High School graduates, undergraduates of post-secondary education, and vulnerable young individuals- unemployed, disadvantaged, migrants- as well as recent young employees, who want to upskill their competences aiming for an upgrade or a new job offer!

The project objectives are:

- Better employment opportunities in their fields of interest for young adults as first-time job seekers.
- Increased productivity for European SMEs through faster on-boarding of new employees and quicker and more efficient contribution to the production process.
- Improved professional capacity of youth trainers to help their audience enter the job market [A minimum of 5 youth organisations and 20 youth workers/trainers per partner country will be involved in project activities from the start of the project].
- Enhanced understanding of the importance of transversal skills in the workplace.

The main project result will be the development of the Transversal Skills Genie, an interactive tool that will develop personalised training pathways by initially testing the knowledge and awareness of learners with respect to soft skills in their sector and then providing personalised training plans.
