Which awareness on soft skills?

Some findings from the surveys

The consortium conducted some surveys to investigate the status quo of soft skills importance and awareness among employers and young and future employees.

The results of questionnaires were gathered in the different partners' countries and a general report has been composed. The survey will allow the consortium to focus on the design of the most suitable methods and tools for individualise the specific lack of knowledge in terms of each soft skill and, consequently, to provide young people with personalized training pathways instead of general training!

The most significant data emerging from the analysis of the survey is that almost all the participants (92% of the total) are aware of the high importance of Soft Skills in terms of employability. Communication Skills are considered as the most important followed very closely by Problem Solving and Team Working Skills. Participants showed a high interest in following a training path to improve and boost their soft skills, which are becoming even more fundamental and crucial in the difficult times of pandemic.
